

PASTOR'S CORNER



After speeding through the holiday season, we need to refuel in order to begin the New Year right. One area in our life that needs refueling is our spiritual life and we do this by cultivating the habit of daily Bible reading. If we are not doing this, we are running on empty spiritually.

The longest chapter in the Bible is Psalm 119 and it is to show us the value of God's Word and the need to fill ourselves daily with it.

- 1. We need to LOOK to the Bible. "Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in Your law" (v. 18).
- 2. We should LEARN from the Bible. "Teach me, Lord, the way of Your decrees, that I may follow it to the end" (v. 33).
- 3. We must LIVE out the Bible. "How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to Your Word" (v. 9).
